Education and Pedagogy

1. Methodology of pedagogical research: setting goals and objectives of research, formulation of hypotheses and research question. Design of the study.
2. The history of pedagogy, significant personalities (J. A. Comenius, J. H. Pestalozzi, M. Montessori, A. S. Makarenko, V. I. Zagvyazinsky, A. M. Novikov, etc.). Classical school. Alternative school.

3. Didactics. The learning process and its patterns. Goal setting and planned educational outcomes. The content of education. Types of activities. Teaching methods.
4. Qualitative, quantitative, and mixed methods. Action research as a practical teaching tool. Mathematical statistics in education.
5. Assessment in the educational process. Assessment of the quality of education.
6. Digital technologies in the educational process. Development of digital educational content based on the concepts of anthropology, cognitive characteristics of the digital generation, and the communication advantages of new media, social networks, and computer games.
7. Hard skills. Soft skills. Set of 4 competencies: cooperation, communication, creativity, critical thinking. Digital competencies.
8. Quality management of school, university, and additional (sports) education in the Russian Federation. The policy and process of setting educational objectives. Legal regulation of the educational process in the Russian Federation.
