# Structure of the video presentation in the post-doctoral track

#### 1. General recommendations

- 1.1 The video presentation of research results by a participant in the post-doctoral track of the Open Doors Russian Scholarship Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Participant") is a video self-introduction. The participant is expected to demonstrate proficiency in English or Russian (the language selected during registration), highlight relevant competencies, command of scientific terminology and research tools, summarize research experience, provide a rationale for selecting the research project (hereinafter referred to as "RP"), and demonstrate the potential to apply the existing competencies to the RP chosen.
- 1.2 The duration of the video presentation should not exceed 600 seconds (10 minutes).
- 1.3 The video presentation must be delivered by the Participant in clear and understandable English or Russian.

# 2. Recommended structure of the video presentation

#### Part 1. Personal information (up to 60 sec)

- Full name, academic degree and year of the doctoral degree award
- Country of residence, position and current place of work

#### Part 2. Research experience and scientific results in the chosen field (up to 300 sec)

- The topic of the doctoral thesis and its main results
- Area/areas of research interest, knowledge of research methods and tools in the area of specialization
- Implemented research projects, the Participant's role in them and the results obtained
- Personal scientific achievements, research results obtained jointly with a research supervisor/consultant, research results obtained in collaborations (name of members of research teams, their academic degree, position and place of work)
- Work experience in a research or educational organization, or a high-tech company

### Part 3. Potential for the application of existing scientific competencies in the RP (up to 120 sec)

- Titles of all research projects of interest, arguments in favor of choosing one or more research projects from the proposed list
- Research objectives within the RP that the Participant is prepared to achieve in the postdoctoral position
- Proficiency in specific research methods and tools that would be relevant for addressing RP aims and objectives in the postdoctoral research

# Part 4. Experience in teaching, research supervision and academic communication (up to 120 sec)

- Teaching experience, disciplines and courses taught, independently designed courses (if any)
- Experience in supervising research activities of students and/or postgraduate students, specific themes of their research works
- Participation in scientific conferences, seminars, and symposia as a speaker in plenary sessions and sections within the field of research;
  experience in organizing scientific events

#### 3. Technical requirements for the video presentation

- 3.1 Video file format: MP4, MOV, WMV, or AVI.
- 3.2 Minimum video resolution: 640x480.
- 3.3 Maximum file size: 1000 MB.
- 3.4 High-quality audio with no background noise and good lighting in the room.
- 3.5 Close-up of the Participant's face, which remain visible on the screen throughout the presentation.
- 3.6 The Participant's speech must be clear and understandable.
- 3.7 Slides may be shown during the video presentation, though they are not mandatory; if slides are displayed, the Participant's face should also be visible on screen alongside the slides.
