# **Program: Education & Psychology**

This document outlines the scope of themes that may be included in the Olympiad tests. The themes are grouped by areas and are followed by the list of recommended references in the Russian and English languages.

# 1. Olympiad winner's skill set by Subject

To win the Olympiad in Education and Psychology, you must display a good grasp of knowledge, skills and competencies. You are expected to:

**be familiar** with the theoretical foundations of pedagogy and psychology, fundamental models of educational systems, the core concepts of both domestic and international approaches, principles governing the interaction between educational organizations and families, management strategies for educational institutions, conflict resolution techniques, as well as fundamental methods for monitoring and assessing educational organizations;

**be able** to develop and analyze educational programs for different education levels, showing a solid understanding of psychological foundations; to introduce novel practice-oriented programs into the educational system; to understand the development prospects of education and psychology, and anticipate problems and risks associated with these fields; to carry out analytical activities in education and psychology; to assess and resolve conflict situations in the educational process; to model pedagogical situations and relationships in parent and coworker groups;

have **skills** in interacting with parent and coworker groups, and use professional competencies to carry out analysis, engage in project-oriented activities, and conduct research.

- 6. *Design of educational technologies and training task development.* Development of test tasks and evaluation systems. Fishbowl strategy, Six Thinking Hats, Jigsaw. Brainstorming techniques.
